Meticulous, considered drawing is the basis for Catherine Pilgrim's practice including lithographs, drawings and occasionally textiles – with absence, contemporary still life and historical narratives influencing recent subject matter.

Catherine has exhibited widely since 1994, when she returned to Australia after studying lithography and drawing in Washington DC, USA. In 2011 Catherine completed her Master of Fine Art (Research) at Monash University, Melbourne. Her research was based on the subjective process of capture, which occurs in making a representational image.

This respected artist has achieved a number of accolades for her intricate works on paper including the *Australian Print Workshop Collie Trust Award for Emerging Printmakers*. Her works are held in public and private collections including the National Gallery of Australia, Geelong Regional Art Gallery, Castlemaine Art Museum, National Australia Bank, Perri Cutten and the Australian War Memorial.
